In SNAP! this is re-named: [When I am clicked]

Note: SCRATCH 2 and 3 versions have separate colours for both Event blocks and Control blocks. In SCRATCH 1.4 all Event and Control blocks were called Control blocks. SNAP! follows the same original colour and Control blocks as SCRATCH 1.4.

Pen blocks

change pen colour by

Sounds blocks contain any Sound (name) that is imported from the Sound library. See how to choose a Sound below.

Note: To import a sound into SCRATCH 3. Find the white-on-blue icon symbol at the bottom of page in your browser. Hover with your mouse over to reveal more options. Use the last of the options to 'Choose a Sound' to import into your project.

For SNAP! Sounds see Menu (where Open and Save is found) look at bottom, of the Menu list, for all 'Sounds'.

Control your Sensor

More Sensor blocks are available, in both SNAP! and SCRATCH.

Sensor blocks are designed to be the exact lozenge shape that fit into the Control blocks (shown left in orange) in Control blocks. Sensor blocks text - such as: ** [ask 'Question' and wait], will expand to fit the lozenge space in a Control block..

Drag and drop a Sensor onto a Control block. It will then become part of that control block. (See left for Control blocks)
