SCRATCH 3 Pen blocks have been moved to 'Add extension' page. Find the 'white-on-blue' symbol at the bottom left of your screen browser. Click to reveal Pen options to import into your code project. There are more Pen blocks that you could use for your coding projects. The basics you need are shown above.

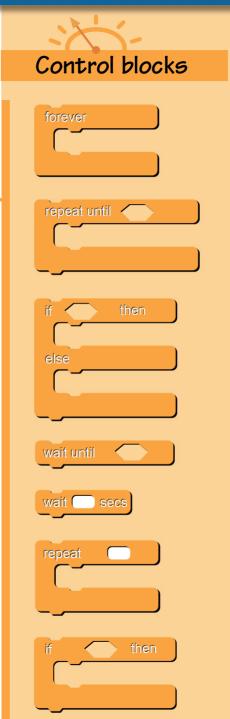

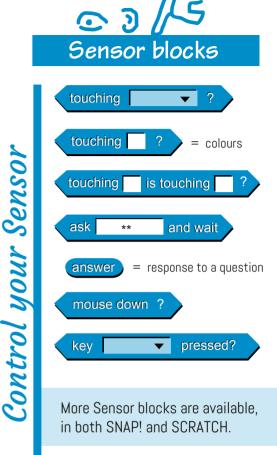

To import a sound into SCRATCH 3. Find the white-on-blue icon symbol at the bottom of page in your browser. Hover with your mouse over to reveal more options. Use the last of the options to 'Choose a Sound' to import into your project.

For SNAP! Sounds see Menu (where Open and Save is found) look at bottom, of the Menu list, for all 'Sounds'.





Sensor blocks are designed to be the exact lozenge shape that fit into the Control blocks (shown left in orange) in Control blocks. Sensor blocks text - such as: ** [ask 'Question' and wait], will expand to fit the lozenge space in a Control block..

Drag and drop a Sensor onto a Control block. It will then become part of that control block. (See left for Control blocks)
